

THE GALLERY 510 FRAME SHOP Choose the Right Moulding

The right frame moulding should enhance a work of fine art without overwhelming it. Several factors can influence which moulding you choose:

1) where will the piece be displayed, 2) does it need to work with other art or objects that are already in that setting, and 3) what style is the artwork. You should also consider the colors, textures and styles of other framed works and objects that are already in the room as well as the style or period of the art.
