

THE GALLERY FRAME SHOP What is a Sandwich Frame?

A sandwich frame is usually made of 2 pieces of acrylic with the photograph or art piece "sandwiched" between the two pieces of acrylic. These are very contemporary and the photographs can be changed out quickly.

Gallery 510 Art & Framing has several options to order. One of our vendors offers a 1 inch thick 5x7 magnetic sandwich frame that holds a 4x6 photograph. It stands on its own without an easel. There are options that also hang on the wall and are connected with brass bolts at the corners. These can be custom ordered to size. Even a treasured book can be "sandwiched" between acrylic and preserved to hang on the wall.
