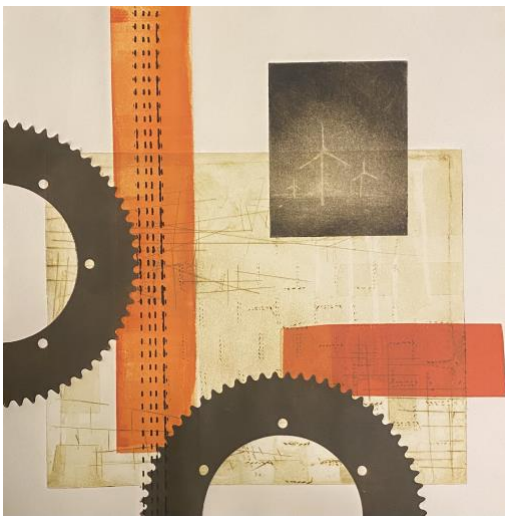

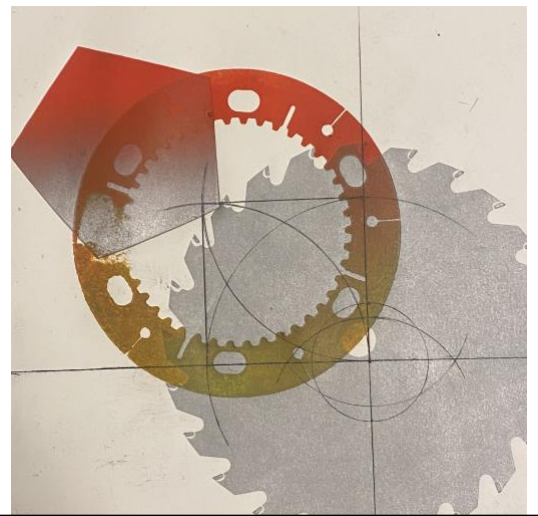

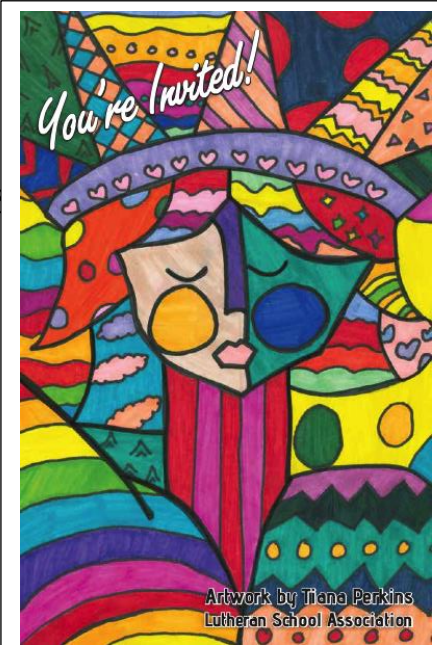

What Material Should I Choose for the Frame?

There is a great variety of materials to choose from and the price varies as well. Gallery 510 has the largest selection in the area for you to choose from. There are ornate wooden frames or simple metals in many colors. Woods come in colors as well. An interesting kind of wood for a landscape or animal portrait is the burl wood. It comes in several color values. The frame will not impact the longevity of the artwork if the mat is archival so you can choose the frame based on your personal preferences and budget. All mats at Gallery 510 are archival.

The most important thing in choosing a frame is whether the frame complements the artwork. Gallery 510 can fill your needs whether it is a white, black or natural wood frame. Whether it is a slim or a wide frame we can help you.
