In MAY we have on display artwork by **ANDIE KOONTZ** from Pana High School. She had this to say: "My favorite type of art to study is Rococo-era oil paintings; the way they executed their brush strokes and the color theory behind each piece is incredible. However, my favorite mediums for my personal work is either digital art or traditional art with nothing more than a pencil/pen. The title of the painting on display is "Amari". I adore birds, & I wanted to incorporate bluejay wings as a focal point of the piece while maintaining a fantastical aesthetic. For this painting, I used Himi Jelly Gouache paints. I paid special attention to the colors in particular: How they blended together, how they contrasted, how the gold hues brought out the depth of the blue."
