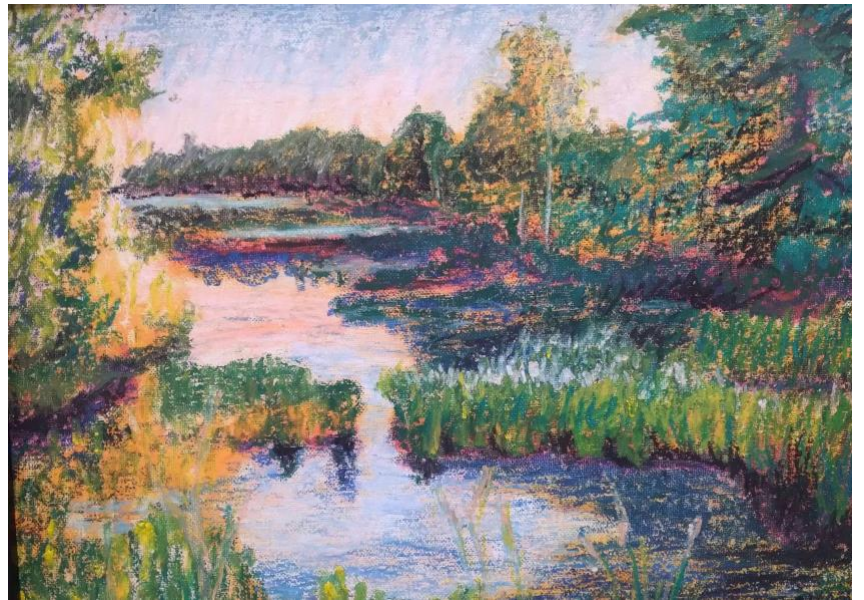

“Sticks, No Brushes”

“My November show features two-dimensional work created since the pandemic, beginning early on at home with oil pastels in a small format, a relatively new medium for me, along with oil paint sticks in a large format. Pastels is the third ‘stick’ that will be represented, a medium I’ve worked with for many years.” During this stay-at-home time of the pandemic, Carol has learned more about the use of oil pastels by studying online and through experimentation. She has studied the pastel landscape techniques of Karen Margulis, changing her approach when creating with pastels and oil paint sticks, too.
